#### • Lake Management Report

##### + Report on status: Rakes Bay upland permit for water flow management

We are now on the 7<sup>th</sup> DNR person responsible for permitting on this project: changing what was already done, serious threat that DNR delays will push beyond the deadline for using funds, and the major project for reducing phosphorus inputs to the lake dies as a result.

##### + Review and consider resolution 2023-2, for weir inspection:

At Rakes Bay. A motion to approve the resolution made by Gene Mazewski, seconded by Dale Maas and approved unanimously.

##### + Report on DU and Pheasants Forever Assistance A meeting will be held at BDLIA offices on July 17 at 9:00 am to discuss preservation of wetlands. BDLD will participate.

##### + Lake Survey: depth & lake bed – Procedure & Schedule

Need to do a test run, send data to DNR and if working we will start the survey. Expecting 20 to 24 hours on the water to complete.

- **Rough Fish Committee Update & Planning-DNR Fishery**

The fisheries biologist is working on the biomass study which involves a harvest after marked fish are returned to the lake. Anticipating Sept/Oct timetable.

- **Report on potential for expanded water safety patrols**

Contacted sheriff's dept and DNR warden. Sheriff patrols the 3 large lakes in Dodge county, tries to cover busy weekends and special events. Stated if we would like patrolling on a particular day, let them know and they will try hard to accommodate. Warden also on the lake a reasonable amount of time, not as visible on purpose.
